Look Who's Talking Now!

Our speaker for this month is Mr. Mark Duncan. His topic will be the theory of constraint management. This program will focus on how to break constraint in any type of organization. The principles that will be taught dealt mainly with application to manufacturing concepts, however any department within a company can use these ideas to make their operation run effective. Prior to speaking at dinner, our professional development session will also be conducted by Mr. Duncan and will focus on a practical exercise in constraint management. Mr. Duncan has been involved in development of training simulations dealing with lean manufacturing under MRP, Just-in-time (Kanban), and Constraint Management. He has worked closely with Toyota in the implementation of the Toyota Production System.
